SUNDAY PRAYER GUIDE | **FEAST OF PASSOVER** (Leviticus 23:4-8)

Passover takes place during the last plague in Egypt, when the angel of death “passed over” the people of Israel who obeyed God to put blood on their doorposts from the lamb that was slain. The Passover is foundational in how we can understand God’s redemptive plan.

Slaying the lamb at Passover foreshadowed the greater redemption found in God’s appointed lamb, the Messiah. What an honor and a privilege that we get to celebrate God’s redemptive plan in our lives for those who have been redeemed by Jesus our Passover Lamb.

⁴ “These are the LORD’s appointed times, the sacred assemblies you are to proclaim at their appointed times. ⁵ The Passover to the LORD comes in the first month, at twilight on the fourteenth day of the month. ⁶ The Festival of Unleavened Bread to the LORD is on the fifteenth day of the same month. For seven days you must eat unleavened bread. ⁷ On the first day you are to hold a sacred assembly; you are not to do any daily work. ⁸ You are to present a food offering to the LORD for seven days. On the seventh day there will be a sacred assembly; do not do any daily work.”

PRAYER POINTS: **GRATEFUL FOR SALVATION IN CHRIST**

1. **Pray** for the proclamation of the Gospel to fill every bible study, small group, and church. **Pray** for the awe of God to be fresh for the preachers/teachers who prepare messages week in and week out.
2. **Pray** that whenever someone opens the Scriptures they would see Christ and would come to understand the love of God. **Pray** that the name of Jesus would spread to every house across cities, nations, and the ends of the earth. **Pray** this verse of Scripture: **Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved (Acts 4:12).**
3. **Ask** God to lay on your heart one person who is far from Christ and begin praying for a heart change. **Pray** that he/she would begin to taste and see His goodness. **Ask** the Holy Spirit to give you boldness and an opportunity to share Jesus.
4. **Praise** God that He brings beauty out of ashes. **Thank** Jesus for destroying the works of the devil (death) in your life. **Thank God** for making **ALL THINGS NEW**.
