“Overcoming Discouragement”
Exodus 14:1-17:7

- 1) Discouragement from Complaints *“Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that you took us out to die in the wilderness?”* (14:11)
- 2) Discouragement from Adverse Circumstances *“They journeyed for three days in the wilderness without finding water.”* (15:22) (photo)
- 3) Discouragement from Irrational Fears *“I will not inflict any illnesses on you that I inflicted on the Egyptians.”* (15:26)
- 4) Discouragement from Comparisons *“We remember the free fish we ate in Egypt, along with the cucumbers, melons, leeks, onions, and garlic. But now our appetite is gone; there’s nothing to look at but this manna!”* (Numbers 11: 5-6)
- 5) The Answer to Discouragement is Trusting God
 - Waiting on the Lord at the Red Sea: *“Stand firm and see the Lord’s salvation”* (14:12)
 - Searching for His answer at Elam: *“So, he cried out to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a tree.”* (15:25)
 - Trusting His promise in the Wilderness of Sin *“The Lord will give you meat to eat this evening and more than enough bread in the morning...”* (16:8)
