“What to do when you’re Under Attack”
Exodus 17:8-15

- I. **Realize that you have an Enemy** *“At Rephidim, Amalek came and fought against Israel.”* (8)

- II. **Recruit your Encouragers** *“Select some men for us and go fight against Amalek”* (9)
 - **Joshua, Aaron and Hur: leadership, companionship, service and support**

- III. **Recognize the Environment** *“When Moses held up his hand, Israel prevailed, but whenever he put his hands down, Amalek prevailed.”* (10)

- IV. **Risk your Ease** *“So Joshua defeated Amalek and his army with the sword.”* (13)
 - **Understand the difference between peacetime conditions and wartime conditions.**

- V. **Rely upon the Enabler** *“The Lord is My Banner”* (15) **Jehovah Nissi**

- VI. **Remember the Event** *“Write this down on a scroll as a reminder...”* (14)

Exo 17:8-15 At Rephidim, Amalek came and fought against Israel. (9) Moses said to Joshua, "Select some men for us and go fight against Amalek. Tomorrow I will stand on the hilltop with God's staff in my hand." (10) Joshua did as Moses had

told him, and fought against Amalek, while Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill. (11) While Moses held up his hand, Israel prevailed, but whenever he put his hand down, Amalek prevailed. (12) When Moses' hands grew heavy, they took a stone and put *it* under him, and he sat down on it. Then Aaron and Hur supported his hands, one on one side and one on the other so that his hands remained steady until the sun went down. (13) So Joshua defeated Amalek and his army with the sword. (14) The LORD then said to Moses, "Write this down on a scroll as a reminder and recite it to Joshua: I will completely blot out the memory of Amalek under heaven." (15) And Moses built an altar and named it, "The LORD Is My Banner."
