## "God's Pattern for Meaningful Worship: Sacrifice" Exodus 37:25-40:38 (cf chapters 26-27)

- A. Worship takes place in an attitude of Prayer "He made the altar of incense..." (37:25; 30:1-10) Ps. 141:2; Luke 1:10; Rev. 5:8; 8:3-4
- **B.** Worship is possible only through Sacrifice "Bezalel constructed the altar of burnt offering..." (38:1; 27:1-8) The priests could not approach the Holy of Holies without first sacrificing. The Lord's Supper reminds us of the sacrifice ("once for all" Heb. 10:10) of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Heb. 13:10-15)
- C. Worship involves Cleansing "He made the bronze basin and its stand from the mirrors of the women who served at the entrance to the tent of meeting." (38:9; 30:18) At the very front of the tabernacle was a basin for washing. (I John 1:9-10)
- D. Worship Is Available Only on God's Terms "The screen for the gate of the courtyard" (38:18; 27:16)
- E. Worship requires offering the best we have "All the gold of the presentation offering that was used for the project, in all the work on the sanctuary, was 2193 pounds..." (about \$55 million) (38:24)
- **F.** Worship results in Service to the Lord (Ex. 39:1-43)
  - 1) God as Worthy "made the ephod of gold, of blue, purple and scarlet yarn, and the fine linen" (2)
  - 2) God as Holy "They also made a medallion, the holy diadem out of pure gold, and wrote on it an inscription like the engraving of a seal: HOLY TO THE LORD." (30)
  - 3) Completing the Task (40:1-38)
    - a. Getting Instructions (1-8) Gate (Jesus), Altar of Sacrifice (Cross), Bronze Laver (Cleansing), Lampstand (Perception), Altar of Incense (Prayer/Praise), Table of Shewbread (Provision), Ark of the Covenant and Mercy Seat (God's Presence).
    - b. Anointing for Service "anoint the tabernacle" (9)

- c. Commissioning the Priests "Clothe Aaron with the holy garments, anoint him and consecrate him..." (13)
- d. Acting in Obedience "Moses did everything just as the Lord had commanded him" (16)
- e. Experiencing God's Glory "...the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle" (34)
