“Becoming the Person God wants you to be through Knowledge”
2 Peter 1:5-7

1) What constitutes Knowledge?

- A. Acts 4:13 “unlearned and ignorant” - Knowledge as formal education**
- B. 1 Cor 14: 23 “unlearned or unbelieving” – Knowledge as Biblical education**
- C. 2 Peter 1:5 “supplement...goodness with knowledge” - Knowledge as the ability to apply Scriptural principles to everyday decisions.**

2) Where do we gain Knowledge?

- A. Prov. 1:7 “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom...”**
- B. 1 Tim 2:4 “God...wants everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth”**
- C. 2 Tim 2:25 “repentance leading to knowledge of the truth”**
- D. Col. 2:3 “All the treasures of wisdom and knowledge are hidden in Him.”**

3) Why do we need Knowledge?

- A. Titus 1:1 – “Knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness”**
- B. Php 3:10 - “My goal is to know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings.”**
- C. Prov. 18:15 – “The mind of the discerning acquires knowledge, and the ear of the wise seeks it.”**
