Results of overcoming these barriers to hospitality:

- Saved souls (Acts 2:47; 2 Cor 5:19) *“That is, in Christ, God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed the message of reconciliation to us.”*
- Transformed community (Acts 2:47; 2 Cor 5:18) *“Everything is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation”*
