# Am I a Disciple?

I Corinthians 11:1 – "Imitate me, as I also imitate Christ." (CSB)

(cf: I Corinthians 4:15-17, I Corinthians 10:32; Philippians 3:17, Philippians 4:9, II Thessalonians 3:7-9, II Timothy 3:10-11- these are on the back of the sheet)

# So what exactly does it mean to be a disciple?

The word <u>disciple</u> refers to a student, pupil, apprentice or learner. A disciple is someone who has totally committed his or her life to the training and teaching of a master or a school of thought.

# Practically, what makes one a disciple?

- 1) A willingness to admit his/her own insufficiency.
- 2) A readiness to do things that no one else will ever know about or notice.
- 3) An eagerness toward humility, accountability & teachability.
- 4) A faithfulness to what God is calling YOU to.

(15) "For you can have 10,000 instructors in Christ, but you can't have many fathers. For I became your father in Christ Jesus through the gospel. (16) Therefore, I urge you to imitate me. (17) This is why I have sent Timothy to you. He is my dearly loved and faithful son in the Lord. He will remind you about my ways in Christ Jesus, just as I teach everywhere in every church."

### 1Co 10:32 HCSB

(32) "Give no offense to the Jews or the Greeks or the church of God,"

### Php 3:17 HCSB

"Join in imitating me, brothers, and observe those who live according to the example you have in us."

## Php 4:9 HCSB

(9) "Do what you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, and the God of peace will be with you."

### 2Th 3:7-9 HCSB

(7) "For you yourselves know how you must imitate us: We were not irresponsible among you; (8) we did not eat anyone's food free of charge; instead, we labored and struggled, working night and day, so that we would not be a burden to any of you. (9) It is not that we don't have the right to support, but we did it to make ourselves an example to you so that you would imitate us."

### 2Ti 3:10-11 HCSB

(10) "But you have followed my teaching, conduct, purpose, faith, patience, love, and endurance, (11) along with the persecutions and sufferings that came to me in Antioch, Iconium, and Lystra. What persecutions I endured! Yet the Lord rescued me from them all."
