- Fretting (25-29) <u>Worry</u> (mentioned six times in these 9 verses) is the symptom of a failure to depend on God. Phil. 4:6 (TLB) "Don't worry about anything, instead pray about everything." In practical terms, Jesus comments, what good can come from worrying?
- 2. Faith (30) "And without faith it is impossible to please God" (Hebrews 11:6a) Worrying is a sign of little faith.
- 3. Father (32) Because God is omnipotent, and God is loving He "knows that you need all these things." Our source for satisfaction, security and significance is our Father.
- 4. First (33) Our priority must be "the kingdom of God and His righteousness." If we seek Him first, He will provide our needs. Our faith is confirmed by His provision. (Saved - "Seek first the Kingdom of God," Sanctified - "and His righteousness," Satisfaction - "and all these things...").
