<i>Abide</i>	Jared C. Wilson	Practicing Kingdom Rhythms in a Consumer Culture. Looks at how to pray intentionally, fast with purpose, serve with joy, feel Scripture, and experience genuine community. (Matthew)
<i>Blemished</i>	Jason Hayes	How the Message of Malachi Confronts Empty Religion. A study of what went wrong in the days of Malachi and a call to self-examination in the church.
<i>Chase the Lion</i>	Mark Batterson	Stepping Confidently Into the Unknown. Inspired by a fearless warrior named Benaiah (2 Samuel); a study for those ready to take on life's risks.
<i>Creation Restored</i>	Matt Carter & Halim Suh	The Gospel According to Genesis. Examines Genesis 12 – 50 and the stories of Abraham, Jacob, and Joseph. Second book in a two-part study.
