Matthew 24: 1-3

The Disciples 2 questions:

- <u>When</u> will this happen?
 Asking about the destruction of the <u>Temple</u>
- <u>What</u> will be the sign of the second coming?
 - Jesus answers by talking about the <u>near</u> <u>event</u>, the destruction of Jerusalem, to serve as a symbol of the <u>far event</u> of his second coming



Matthew 24: 4-8

<u>NOT</u> indicators of the end of age:

- <u>False Messiahs</u>
- Wars
- Nations rising against nations
- <u>Famines</u>
- Earthquakes

The above are **<u>birth</u>** pains

• <u>Inescapable</u> and <u>repetitive</u> waves of pain until the end



Matthew 24: 9-12

Warning to the disciples:

- You will be <u>persecuted</u>
- Many will fall away
- Watch out for <u>false prophets</u>
 - Prophecy about the future is given for the purpose of <u>affecting behavior</u> in the <u>present</u>
 - Be <u>Spiritually discerning</u>, look for the hand that lies behind prophecies to see where it truly comes from
- Spiritual Death
 - Increase wickedness and lovelessness



Matthew 24: 13-14

<u>Stand firm</u> and <u>share</u> the <u>gospel</u> to ALL nations
After the gospel is preached to all nations the end will come



Matthew 24

For the remainder of Chapter 24 and 25, Jesus deals with <u>attitudes</u> that should characterize <u>believers</u> who live during this age and those who await his coming.



Matthew 24: 32-35

Stay Alert! - Don't Lose Hope

Lesson of the Fig Tree

- Oppression will not go on forever. Summer is near
- We need to maintain <u>hope</u> and <u>determination</u>



Matthew 24: 36-42

Stay Alert! - Don't Lose Hope

That day and hour - <u>No one knows</u>!

- We cannot make known what Jesus has declared to be <u>unknown</u>
- Don't be so caught up in everyday activities that you have no concern for righteousness or <u>spiritual realities</u> of walking with the Lord and <u>not walking</u> with the Lord
- God's judgment is handing us over to <u>ourselves</u>, God gives us what <u>we</u> want, and this does not lead to true <u>life</u>.



Matthew 24: 45-51 Be Ready!

The Parable of the Homeowner and the Thief

- Be ready in <u>faithfully caring</u> for God's people
- The way we <u>think</u>, treat others, and live righteously or unrighteously exposes our <u>heart</u>.
- The <u>church</u> is the primary way that the <u>gospel</u> is made known to a <u>watching</u> world
 It is our responsibility to make the gospel known by all that we <u>are</u> and <u>say</u>



Matthew 25: 1-13

Be Prepared!

The Parable of the 10 Virgins
We must be <u>spiritually</u> prepared to meet Jesus

- We are prepared when our relationship with <u>God</u> and with <u>others</u> is what they should be
- We are prepared when at <u>any moment</u> we are <u>not ashamed</u> to have the Lord meet us.



Matthew 25: 14-30 Be Productive!

The Parable of the Talents
It's not a one size fits all <u>kingdom</u> and the <u>same thing</u> is <u>not expected</u> of everybody in terms of results

 But <u>SOMETHING</u> is expected from everybody

The Master is about bringing people along and <u>helping</u> them <u>discover</u> and <u>become</u> who they are capable of being.
Our <u>behavior</u> is a window into our <u>character</u>



Matthew 25: 31-46 The Final Judgment

- When Jesus calls us to follow him he <u>expects</u> us to actually <u>follow</u> him
 - Jesus' mission is to create a people who <u>become</u> a blessing to <u>everyone</u> else. We are to be a <u>sign</u> and a <u>symbol</u> of the kingdom and how God treats the marginalized and vulnerable
- **<u>Don't</u>** feed the narrative of "I can't measure up"
 - <u>Wrong story</u>! Jesus has so much joy in you and he knows that you will become the best version of yourself if you <u>follow him</u>
