Worship

- We are made to worship. Everyone worships something or someone.
 - We worship whatever is the central object of our attention and/or affection



Worship

- Worship to Jesus is never wasteful, but always right.
- The anointing of Jesus by Mary of Bethany was a deeply theological task, recognizing him as the Lamb of God and King of kings.
- Expect extravagant worship to Jesus to be misunderstood and even criticized



Waste

- We won't worship Jesus in the wrong places
 - Is Jesus your slave or your king?
 - What is your salvation worth to you?



Worship

- Worship Jesus for being broken for us, for the complete forgiveness of sins, and for communion with him through the new covenant



War

- Where is your Gethsemane, the place where you have been deeply grieved?
 - Can you say not my will but Your will be done?





War

- Between the crushing and the remaking, we need people and prayer
 - Are you spiritually sleeping or alert to what God is doing?



Waywardness

- Be confident in the grace and prayers of God, not the ability of you
- Following Jesus from a distance brings denial, betrayal and bitterness
 - Be aware that Satan still wants to sift the saints

- Allow your failures to teach you humility and childlike dependence on God
 - Remember that remorse is not the same as repentance
