The Beatitudes describe the now and not yet kingdom of Christ through the <u>present</u> reality of His followers, making this upside-down world <u>right side up.</u>



Jesus embodies the law and <u>fulfills</u> it perfectly. All of Israel's law and prophecy came true in the person of Jesus.

1. Jesus kept and taught the commandments in purity and perfection, modeling <u>real</u> righteousness that was both <u>internal</u> and external, centered on the <u>love</u> of God and others, not legalism. Our behaviors are <u>symptoms</u> of a sick or well heart.

Our <u>affections</u> drive our actions



#### "You have heard that it was said ... But I tell you ..."

- Murder ... <u>reconcile quickly</u>
- Adultery ... guard your heart and mind
- Divorce ... <u>honor your spouse</u>
- Oaths ... <u>tell the truth and keep promises</u>
- Retaliation ... <u>refuse to retaliate</u>
- Enemies ... <u>be known by love</u>



### The command to be perfect is a call to pursue <u>holiness:</u>

- Positional holiness
- Practical holiness

*"Speak to the entire assembly of Israel and say to them: Be holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy."* Leviticus 19:2



#### What we do in <u>private</u> surpasses what we do in <u>public</u>.

1. **Giving:** do you seek the <u>approval</u> of people or of God?

"Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ." Galatians 1:10



#### What we do in private surpasses what we do in public.

2. **Praying:** is your prayer life more about <u>God</u> and <u>others</u> or <u>you</u>?

- The Lord's prayer is a <u>model</u> more than a mantra. His <u>Name</u>, His <u>Kingdom</u>, His <u>Will</u>.
- Prayer is <u>personal</u> not prescriptive
- Are we <u>listening</u> and <u>talking</u> to God?
- God's design is for us to <u>worship</u> and seek Him <u>daily</u> for practical needs, <u>forgiveness</u>, and protection from temptation.



#### What we do in private surpasses what we do in public.

3. Fasting: Is fasting for you a <u>diet</u> or a spiritual <u>discipline</u> of prayer? Fasting should <u>transform</u> us, not trigger us.

"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter – when you see the naked, to clothe them, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood? ... Then you will call, and the Lord will answer; you will cry for help, and he will say: Here am I." Isaiah 58:6-8

#### Seek <u>eternal</u>, not immediate rewards

- 1. Do you treasure Christ more than <u>people</u>, <u>positions</u>, or <u>possessions</u>?
- 2. Do you treat others the way you want to be treated, in spite of <u>cost</u>?
- 3. Do you live for the kingdom of \_\_\_\_ or the kingdom of God?
  - Invite God's <u>Lordship</u> over your life that results in peace, protection, and freedom.

#### You are worth more than <u>worry.</u>

- 1. Do you crave God's <u>will</u> and <u>way</u> over the world's, which leads to <u>peace</u> and <u>clarity</u> not strife and confusion.
- 2. Daily <u>dependence</u> on God protects us from <u>anxiety</u> and ungodly <u>ambition</u>.

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Phil. 4:6-7

## To judge is to condemn based on the <u>cover</u>, not <u>character</u>.

## To discern is necessary to <u>separate</u> good from bad fruit.

*"Stop judging by mere appearances, but instead judge correctly."* John 7:24

*"The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."* 1 Samuel 16:7



#### Being a <u>citizen</u> of God's kingdom always results in a <u>changed</u> life

- 1. Jesus is the <u>only way</u> to God the Father and heaven. Seek Him and Him alone for salvation and security
- 2. Be encouraged: The firm <u>foundation</u> of the Lord will never <u>fail!</u>



#### **Bottom line**:

Life in the <u>Kingdom</u> will look different than life in the <u>world</u>, because we rest wholly in the Savior not self.

*His Kingdom* come, *His will* be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
