- It is listed as a divine calling (Ephesians 4:11).
- It was considered necessary for the officer of the early church (1 Tim. 3:2).
- It is imperative for all ministers (2 Tim. 2:24-26).
- Teaching was done from house to house (Acts 20:20).
- Christian teaching was derived from the activities of Jesus Christ (Matt. 2:19).

What Is Christian Teaching? (cont.)

- It is empowered by the Holy Spirit (John 14:26).
- God is the ultimate teacher in any Christian teaching setting (Isa. 54:13).
- Christian teaching was originated in divine revelation (Gal. 1:12).
- Although all the basic rules of teaching apply to Christian teaching there is a depth of spiritual assistance for the Christian teacher that is not available in other teaching situations.
