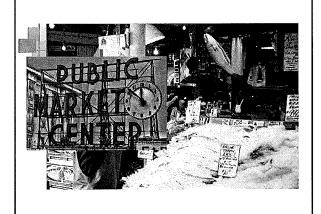




## Making the Bible the Basis

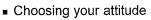

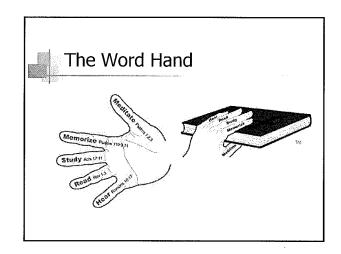




### Think about their maturity stage
