 - Realize loss will come John 16:33
 - 1) Loss can be the beginning, <u>strengthening</u>, or ending of people's faith Isaiah 55:8–9
 - 2) "Perceived loss" can be just as powerful
 - The Lord is the only solid refuge in times of loss Psalm 46:1
