
Discovering God's Will, Pt. 2 The God of God's Will

- Honor God in your normal routine Exodus 3:1
- Notice and investigate the "strange sights" God brings Exodus 3:2-3
- Watch to see if the bush burns up
- Reverently respond, "Here I Am" Exodus 3:4-6
- . The God of God's Will
 - Compassionate and Caring
 Nehemiah 9:19, 27-28: Psalm 119:77 & 156
 - "I Am who I Am" <u>Timeless</u> and Self Existent Hebrews 13:8; Revelation 1:4; John 8:58
 - Provides goats, bees, and gold
- God's Will is about God, not us Psalm 115:1
 - We humbly respond Numbers 12:3
 - Do not confuse the by products of God's will with the essence Matthew 6:33
 - The Essence of God's will is God's worship
