

## Discovering God's Will, Pt. 4

Exodus 5 & 6

- Discovering God's Will is the result of discovering God.
- God's Will might become worse <u>before</u> it gets better. 1 Corinthians 15:36; John 12:24, Isaiah 65:3
  - "Be more concerned with God's glory than your relief." Red Sea Rule #2; p.17
  - <u>Turn to God</u> not the enemy, and declare your desire to serve.
- God's Will may appear lazy to the self reliant.
- Bottom Line: God's Will requires God.
