Plagues and Purposes

Stage 1: God's Presence

1. Blood → God's power over life

2. Frogs → God's power over goddess Heqet

3. Gnats → God's power over the magicians

Stage 2: God's Providence

4. Flies → only on Egyptians

5. Livestock → gods can't protect wealth

6. Boils → gods cant protect health

Stage 3: God's Power

7. Hail→ God controls the weather

8. Locust - tell the next generation

9. Darkness → God controls the Heavens

Culmination: Now it's Personal

10. First born → God's power over life

Passover→ shines with Power and points to Christ
