The purpose of prophecy is godliness.

•Three arrows and two lines:



- The Day of the Lord: a time <u>period</u> in which God interviews in history, primarily for judgment. (Tyndale Bible Dictionary)
- Three Judgments and Eternal Rewards:

Part 2: Eternal Rewards

1 Thessalonians 5:1-3 (p. 837)

1) First realize the <u>cross</u>	was the ultimate judgment of sin.
Colossians 2:13-14 (p. 834)	

- 2) The Judgment (Bema) Seat of Christ for believers is <u>evaluation</u> not salvation.
 - Based on faithfulness Ephesians 6:8; Matthew 12:41-43; 1 Corinthians 3:10-15 (p. 830; 690; 808)
 - Eternal Rewards
 - His presence and praise Matthew 13:46; 25:23 (p. 691; 702)
 - Reigning with Him Revelation 5:10; 20:6 (p. 870; 878)
 - Ammo for worship Revelation 4:10 (p. 869)
 - The goal of eternal rewards is to <u>increase</u> our capacity for worship.
- 3) The Great White Throne Judgment is for unbelievers who trusted their works and not Christ's work on the cross. Revelation 20:15 (p. 878)
