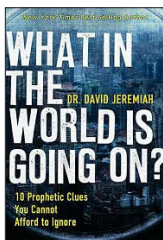

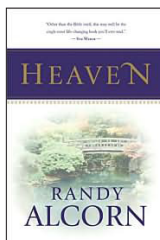
1 Thessalonians 5:8-11 (p. 837)

## Part 1: The Rapture 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

- Three arrows and two lines, to explain the End Times



- ↑ **Rapture:** Christ coming for His church 1 Corinthians 15:50-58; John 14:1-3
- ~ **Tribulation:** 7 years of worldwide calamity Revelation 6-19; 2 Thessalonians 2
- ↓ **Second Coming of Christ:** He comes with His church Revelation 19:11-21
- **Millennium:** 1000 year reign of Christ on earth with His people Revelation 20
- **Eternity:** New heaven and earth for believers; hell for unbelievers Revelation 21

- Thoughts of Why A Pretribulation Rapture

- **OT examples** of saints removed before wrath comes; i.e. Noah, Lot, and Rahab
- **Revelation:** The word "church" not mentioned in Revelation 6-19 when the Tribulation is described Revelation 3:10; 4:1-2; 6-19
- **1 Thessalonians:** 1 Thessalonians 4:17 uses "we" for the Rapture and "them" in 1 Thessalonians 5:3 for the Tribulation; 1 Thessalonians 5:9 concludes Paul's discussion

## Part 2: Eternal Rewards 1 Thessalonians 5:1-3

- The purpose of prophecy is godliness.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:3, The Day of the Lord: a time period in which God intervenes in history, primarily for judgment. (Tyndale Bible Dictionary)
- Three Judgments (push pins) and Eternal Rewards
  - A. The cross was the ultimate judgment of sin. Colossians 2:13-14
  - B. The Judgment (Bema) Seat of Christ for believers is for evaluation not for salvation. Eternal rewards are based on faithfulness. Ephesians 6:8; Matthew 12:41-43; 1 Corinthians 3:10-15
    1. Our Eternal Rewards
      - a. His presence and praise Matthew 13:46; 25:23
      - b. Reigning with Him: Revelation 5:10; 20:6
      - c. Ammo for worship; Casting crowns at Christ's feet. The goal of life is to increase our capacity for worship in heaven (i.e. Eternal Rewards) Revelation 4:10
    - C. The Great White Throne Judgment is for salvation. Since the unbeliever's righteousness was not exchanged for Christ's at the cross, they stand on their own righteousness at the GWT. Therefore, none will be saved. Revelation 20:15
