  - 1) Spirit  $\longrightarrow$  connects us with God
  - 2) Soul  $\longrightarrow$  connects us with <u>ourselves</u>
  - 3) Body  $\longrightarrow$  connects us with life
- His call + His faithfulness = <u>His actions</u> Colossians 1:29; John 15:5 (p. 833; 764)
- Growing believers continually return to "The Return of Christ".
