- Five Theories of Creation
 - 1. Atheistic Evolution time and chance produced life and order.
 - 2. Theistic Evolution God was the cause and guide of evolution.
 - 3. <u>Gap</u> Theory unknown amount of time between Genesis 1:1 and 1:2.
 - 4. Day/Age Theory "day" is <u>poetic</u> or relative therefore could be ages. 2 Peter 3:8
 - 5. Literal <u>Six</u> Days Theory In 24 hour periods God creates with the appearance of age. Exodus 20:11
- Creation: <u>Design</u> or Chance?
 - How did nothing become something? Hebrews 11:3
 - How does something become life?

Requirements for Life:

• Changes in the Gravitational Force by only 1 part in 10⁴⁰ would have precluded the existence of stars (including our sun), making life impossible. (1)

- The Slant of the Earth, tilted at 23 degrees produces our seasons. If not tilted exactly as it is, vapors from the oceans would move north and south, piling up continents of ice. (1)
- **The Sun** is 93 million miles away and 11,500°F on its surface. If its heat hit Earth at 50°F more or less, life would cease. (2)
- The Earth's Rotation is at 1,000 mph. If slowed by 100 mph, we would freeze up or burn up. (2)
- The Earth's Crust is thinner than an apple skin in relation. If 10 ft. thicker, the available oxygen would be oxidized. (2)
- The Earth's Elliptical Orbit is 64,800 mph. If slowed by 1/3 we would burn up. (2)
- **The Moon** is 240,000 miles away. If 1/5 closer, the tides would cover the continents twice a day. (2)
