- How to win over temptation:

- 1. Realize sin is chocolate covered dog food to Christians. Jeremiah 2:13: Romans 7:19-22
- 2. Gorge ourselves on the freely given and we will not be hungry for the forbidden. Psalm 81:10: John 4:13-14
- 3. Realize temptation begins with deception and ends with guilt. Hebrews10:22: Hebrews 9:14: Ezekiel 36:24-27
