"Wisdom Works for Finances" – Wisdom Works (Part 3)

Proverbs 10: 2-6, 9 (NIV), 10: 16 (TLB)

I. Honor God

"Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits..." (3:9)

II. Save regularly

"Go to the ant you sluggard; consider its ways and be wise! ...it stores its provisions in summer and gathers its food at harvest." (6:6-8)

III. Spend Intentionally

"Do not wear yourself out to get rich; have the wisdom to show restraint. Cast but a glance at riches and they are gone, for they will surely sprout wings and fly off to the sky like an eagle." (23:4-5)

IV. Fear Debt

"The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender." (22:7)

V. Deal Honestly

"Dishonest money dwindles away, but he who gathers money little by little makes it grow." (13:11)

VI. Pray for the **Best** / Plan for the **Worst**

"Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your lands; for riches do not endure forever..." (27 : 23-24a)
