3 Questions to Ask

- Do you have any spiritual beliefs?
- If God was included in your situation how would it change? Positive or negative?
- If you died today do you know for sure you would go to heaven? Why?

Hand Presentation

GRACE **THUMB**
(hitchhiker, free ride)
Heaven is a free gift
(Romans 6:23)
It is not earned or deserved
(Ephesians 2:8-9)

MAN **INDEX FINGER**
(points out sin)
Man is a sinner
(Romans 3:23)
He cannot save himself
(Matthew 5:48)

GOD **GREAT FINGER**
(greatest Being in universe)
GOD is merciful and doesn't want to punish us
(1 John 4:8b)
But, God is also just and must punish our sin (Exodus 34:7b)

CHRIST **RING FINGER**
(Bridegroom)
Christ is both God and man
(John 1:1,14)
He died on the cross and rose from the dead to pay the penalty for our sins and purchase a place in Heaven for us (Isaiah 53:6)

FAITH **LITTLE FINGER**
(Faith of a mustard seed)
Saving Faith is not just head knowledge nor just temporary faith
(James 2:19)
Saving Faith is trusting in Jesus Christ alone for our eternal life
(Acts 16:31)
