Transformation From the Inside OutJohn 2:12-25

Memory Verse

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.

John 3:16-17

1 Cleansing begins on the inside.

"In the temple courts He found men selling cattle, sheep and doves and others sitting at tables exchanging money. So He made a whip out of cords, and drove all from the temple area..." (John 2:14-15a)

2 Passion is revealed on the outside.

"Zeal for your house will consume Me." (John 2:17, cf. Psalms 69:9)

3 Your temple is transformed from the inside /out.

"But the temple He had spoken of was His body" (John 2:21) "Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit...?" (1 Corinthians 6:19)

- Motives are important to God. (John 2:18, 23-25)
- · Commitment is made in faith, based on facts. (John 2:21-22)
- God wants more <u>for</u> you than is naturally in you "...He knew what was in a man." (John 2:25b)
