Memory Verse

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.

John 3:16-17

- God so loved the world: Our God <u>loves</u>.
 1 Chronicles 16:34, Psalm 103:11, Psalm 100:5, 1 John 4:7
 - World (kosmos: the inhabitants of the earth, men, the human family)
 Used 78 times in John.
- He gave His Son: Love results in action.

 1 John 4:9, 1 John 3:16, 1 John 5:1-3
 - **Begotten** (*monogenēs*: one and only)
 Jesus inherits all from the Father.
- Whoever believes will not perish but have eternal life: <u>Belief</u> changes destination. Matthew 8:10-12, Matthew 7:20-23, Romans 4:19-21
 - Whoever (pas: all, everyone) Used 1,228 times in the New Testament. Hebrews 2:9, 2 Peter 3:9, 1 Timothy 2:3-4
 - Perish (apollymi: to be destroyed or utterly lost)
