Sanctity of Human Life Sunday

In 2005, the number of abortions in the U.S. declined to 1,2 million, 25% below the all-time high of 1,6 million in 1990. Despite this decline, slightly more than one in five pregnancies ended in abortion in 2005, giving the U.S. one of the highest abortion rates in the developed world.

Who Has Abortions?

- 56% of women having abortions are in their 20s
- 61% have one or more children
- 67% have never married
- · 57% are economically disadvantaged
- · 88% live in a metropolitan area
- 78% report a religious affiliation, including 13% who identify themselves as "born again" or evangelical Source: The Guttmacher Institute, guttmacher.org

The Lingering Effects of Abortion

Women who have had abortions show symptoms that fit the model of post-traumatic stress disorder.

• Guilt - 92.6%

Depression - 88.2%

• Grief - 84.7%

Rearet - 84.8%

Loneliness - 83.6%

Loss of self-esteem - 82.3%

Anxiety - 81.4%

Anger - 80.8%
