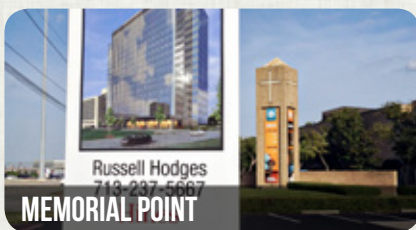

A proposed project of Hines

A sign in the west parking lot at the Loop features a 16-story office tower and the name of one of the world's leading developers. No, the sign wasn't put up in the wrong place and ground will not be broken any time soon. However, this proposed project by Hines could one day be a reality.

In 2007, Houston's First and Hines reached an agreement for the developer to lease the land from us and provide us with access to a 1,500 space parking garage on Sundays and after normal business hours during the week. The economic downturn in our nation soon followed and the project was put on hold indefinitely.

Now that the construction climate is more favorable, Hines is once again seeking potential tenants. Called Memorial Point, the tower would offer 400,000 square feet of space and the adjacent garage. Construction would only begin once a certain amount of space is pre-leased.
