- 63 A.D. — 1 Peter is written.
- 64 A.D. — Fire in Rome. Nero persecuted Christians as scapegoats.
- 67 A.D. — Peter and Paul martyred possibly on the same day. (Peter was around 75 years old.)
- 68 A.D. — Nero flees and commits suicide.
- 70 A.D. — Temple in Jerusalem destroyed by Roman army.
