Cell Phone Contract

This cell phone contract is between and his/her parent(s):

Student Responsibilities

- I understand that having a cell phone is a privilege and if I fail to adhere to this contract, my cell phone 1. privilege may be revoked.
- I understand my phone belongs to my parent(s). The rules and appropriate usage are determined by my 2. parent(s).
- 3. I will not be on my phone while our family is spending time together unless I ask permission.
- 4. I will not send gossip, rude, or mean texts to others.
- I will not text or place phone calls after 9 p.m. without permission. At that time my phone is placed in the 5. charger or given to my parent(s).
- 6. I will always keep my phone charged.
- I will not bring my cell phone to the family dinner table. 7.
- I will not go over our plan's monthly minutes or text message limits. If I do, I understand that I may be 8. responsible for paying any additional charges or that I may lose my cell phone privileges.
- 9. I understand that I am responsible for knowing where my phone is, and for keeping it in good condition.
- 10. I understand that my cell phone may be taken away if I talk back to my parent(s), I fail to do my chores, or I fail to keep my grades up.
- 11. I will seek to be respectful and polite in public places. I will make sure my phone is turned off or on mute/vibrate when I am in church, in restaurants, school, or quiet settings.
- 12. I will obey any rules my school has regarding cell phones, such as turning them off during class or keeping them on vibrate.
- 13. I promise I will alert my parent(s) when I receive suspicious or alarming phone calls or text messages.
- 14. I will not send embarrassing or inappropriate photos of my family, friends, or myself to others. In addition, I will not use my camera's phone to take embarrassing or inappropriate photos of others or myself.
- 15. I understand that my phone is mainly for talk and text not the Internet.
- 16. I will always do my best to answer a call or reply to a text from my parent(s).
- 17. I understand I'm responsible for ______ of the monthly expense of my phone.
- 18. I understand my phone will not be a source of contention or fighting with my parent(s). If it is, my privileges may be revoked.
