

Stock Gifts and Year-End Giving Year End Giving

The church business office will be open until 4:30 PM on Monday, December 31, 2007 to receive contributions that will qualify as a 2007 donation. Any donations received via mail will



be treated as a 2007 donation if the postmark date on the envelope is before January 1, 2008. In addition, any donations made via the church's website at HoustonsFirst.org before midnight on December 31, 2007 will qualify as a 2007 donation. Gifts of Securities

The gifting of stock to the church is a "win-win" situation for both the donor and the church. Since the church is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, the gift will qualify as a charitable contribution and is tax deductible.

For example: Assume you own 1,000 shares of XYZ Corporation for which you paid \$10 per share, for a total investment of \$10,000. The stock is currently worth \$20 per share, for a total value of \$20,000. Assuming that you had held the stock over a year, and then sold the stock and donated the proceeds to the church, you would incur a capital gain tax, as high as 15%. (The maximum tax rate on a short-term gain is even higher) Thus, you would pay \$1,500 in taxes before giving anything to the church.

A better strategy is to donate the stock directly to the church, thus avoiding any capital gain tax. This is a very simple and easy process that can be coordinated through the Financial Services office of the church. On all tax questions, it is advisable to consult with your tax advisor or CPA.

To make a gift of securities, please review the instructions at HoustonsFirst.org and click on the Giving/Gifts of Securities navigation tabs in the left margin.

IRA Distributions under the Pension Protection Act

In addition to the above, as a result of the Pension Protection Act of 2006, individuals aged 70 ½ or older are eligible to make a donation to a charity from their IRA. This provision will expire on December 31, 2007. Because this distribution is not included in an individual's taxable income, individuals will not be able to claim a deduction for their charitable contribution. Please consult with your financial institution for more information regarding this provision.





Give Sacrificially to the World Mission Offering

The World Mission Offering, given annually from **December through February**, is money above tithes and dispersed by the Missions Development Council of Houston's First Baptist Church. The funds are distributed to the following national Southern Baptist organizations:

The International Missions Board designated to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, 100% of which goes to fund the

overseas mission budget where our IMB missionaries are on the field. **The North American Missions Board** designated to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering.

Southern Baptist of Texas State Missions designated to state missions.

Generally, the guidelines for disbursement of total World Mission Offering received by February 29 are approximately as follows: IMB 85%, NAMB 10%, SBTC 5%.
