





The World Mission Offering, given annually from **December** through February, is money above tithes and dispersed by the Missions Development Council of Houston's First Baptist Church. The funds are distributed to the following national Southern Baptist organizations:

The International Missions Board designated to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, 100% of which goes to fund the

overseas mission budget where our IMB missionaries are on the field.

The North American Missions Board designated to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering.

Southern Baptist of Texas State Missions designated to state missions.

Generally, the guidelines for disbursement of total World Mission Offering received by February 29 are approximately as follows: IMB 85%, NAMB 10%, SBTC 5%.
