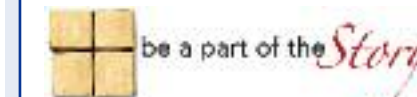

Welcome Lee Hsia as the Minister of New Initiatives



Lee’s first seven years were in communist China before his family immigrated to Houston. Raised as a nominal Buddhist, he came to Christ as a high schooler when someone left a New Testament on his driveway. After graduating from Rice in 1995, he worked as a consultant for Fortune 500 companies. More recently, God called him into full time Christian service. He comes to us from Evangelism Explosion, where he served over 350 churches as the Regional Director in Dallas. He has also served on the Houston Metro Development Board for Campus Crusade.

The position of New Initiatives involves implementing visionary goals of Pastor Gregg. Initially, Lee will work on outreach strategies to the Latino and Asian communities (he speaks Shanghainese and Mandarin Chinese plus Spanish, French and Italian). In the fall, he will begin implementing XEE, a version of Evangelism Explosion especially targeting generations X and Y. In addition, he will assume responsibility for the “Godly, Effective, Excellent” strategy for HFBC staff development. Lee will assist Pastor Gregg in implementing several one time events including the Southern Baptist of Texas Pastors’ Conference.

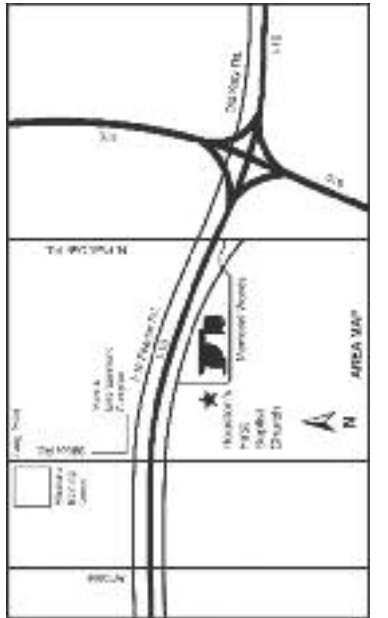
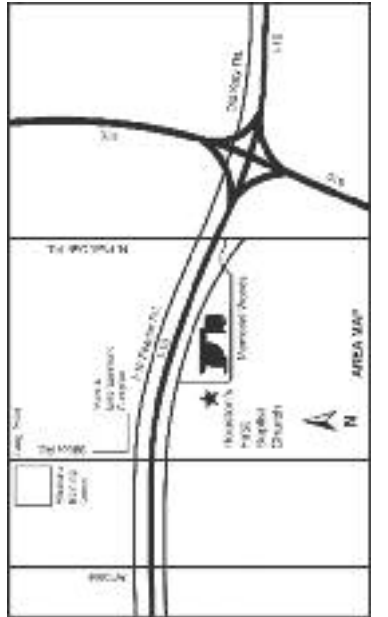

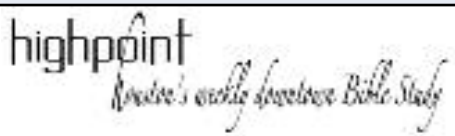
