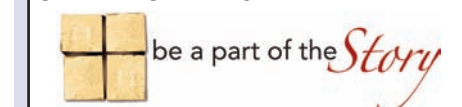

Counseling Center Celebrates 25th Anniversary

June marks the 25th anniversary of the Julianna Poor Memorial Counseling Center (JPMCC) at Houston's First Baptist Church. The JPMCC provides Biblically-Based, Clinically-Competent and Spirit-Sensitive counseling. This is the second in a series of articles about the JPMCC's approach to counseling as we celebrate this significant milestone!

What is Clinically-Competent counseling?

The State of Texas has some of the most rigorous standards for professional counselors in the country. These standards include undergraduate and graduate degree requirements, practicum program while working on a master's degree (think "on-the-job training"), post graduation internship requiring 3,000 hours of supervised counseling, and a nationally-recognized licensure examination. In the JPMCC, the staff sees these rigorous standards as just the minimum. All of their counselors are either fully-licensed or pursuing licensure. Many of the counselors hold more than one license. They attend professional continuing education on a regular basis. At least once a month, the counseling center staff comes together for training in the integration of psychology and theology, with an emphasis on spiritual direction – finding God's movement in your life.

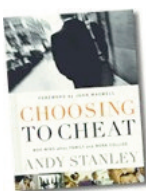
The JPMCC has a commitment to the next generation of Christian counselors with a practicum program that is approved by all of the educational institutions – secular and religious – in the area. They have three counselors approved as supervisors by the State of Texas, and they have an active internship program.

The JPMCC staff believes that a person should not have to settle for less just because they want a Christian counselor. In fact, they believe that the call from God to excellence requires that everything they provide be over-and-above what a client could purchase in the marketplace. For the JPMCC, being clinically-competent is a no-brainer.

How Things Work: Operating Budget of Houston's First Baptist Church

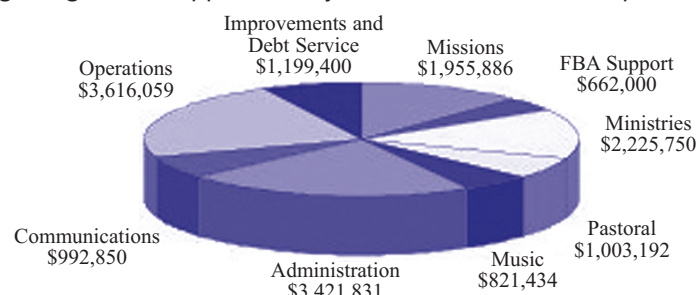
The church applies undesignated tithes and offerings toward the operating budget, which is voted on by the church body every year.

The Finance Committee of the church meets on a monthly basis to review the church's financials. A summary of the church's monthly financials is presented to the Deacons and the church body at the monthly church conference.

On June 22, 2008, at 4:45 PM, all members are invited to attend the church conference held in the Chapel. As a part of the church conference, the church will vote on the proposed operating budget for fiscal year ended 2009.

For the fiscal year beginning July 2008 and ending June 2009, the church's proposed operating budget totals approximately \$15.9 million and is composed of the following:



Missions includes Woodhaven Deaf Church, Missions Training Center, New Members, Connection and Community, Missions Staff, Support of other churches/ministries throughout the city and world, and the Christian Life Center. When including both operating budget expenditures as well as designated donations to Missions (donor designated donations to Missions typically exceed \$2 million), total expenditures on Missions activity constitute 22% of all donations received.

First Baptist Academy (FBA) is a Pre-K through 8th grade private school. Support consists of \$255,000 to pay for discounts for church members, and a subsidy for the school of \$407,000. FBA is a separate non-profit entity that leases property from the church, with a Board of Trustees that includes both church members and non-church members.

Ministries includes all Sunday Bible Study Departments and Classes. Includes staff salaries, as well as program budget money for age specific ministries - Preschool through Senior Adult, as well as Women's, Men's, and Adult Enrichment ministries, including camps, retreats, special events, and leadership training.

Pastoral includes the Pastoral office, New Initiatives, Deacon budget, Pastoral Care, and Counseling.

Administration includes the Administration budget, of which property and liability insurance is the greatest expenditure, and Personnel budget, which consists primarily of benefits for the entire church staff.

Communications includes salary and budget money for Membership Services, Graphics, Resource Center, Garden Bookstore, and the Communications office, which provides oversight of these groups as well as direction regarding the church's advertising budget.

Operations includes salaries and budget money for Facilities, Systems, Financial Services, Church Calendar, Special Events/Weddings, Hunt Retreat, and Food Service.

Loan payments are \$949,400, and Capital Improvement money is \$250,000 for upkeep of the building, such as new carpet and new furniture.

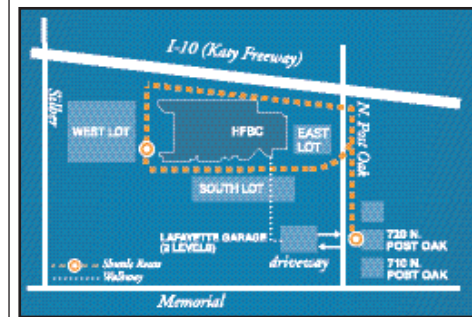

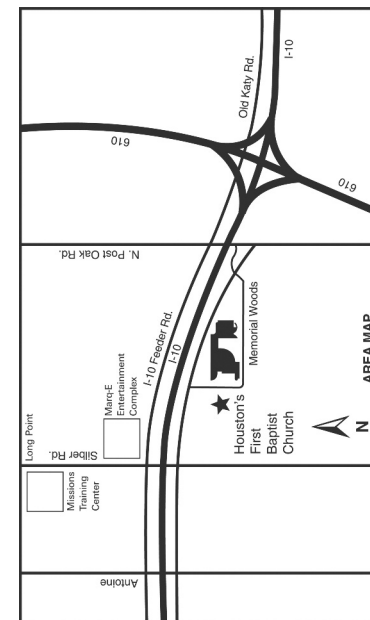
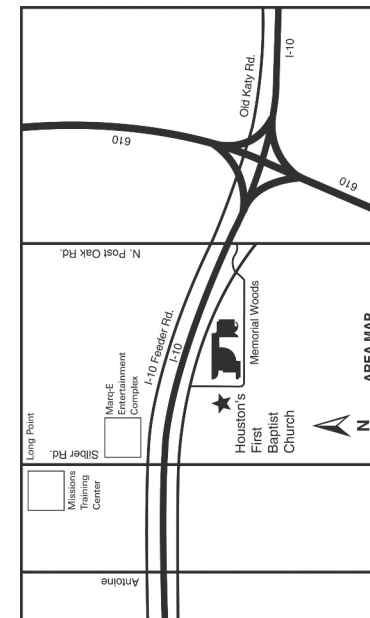
