Counseling Center Celebrates 25th Anniversary

June marks the 25th anniversary of the Julianna Poor Memorial Counseling Center (JPMCC) at Houston's First Baptist Church. The JPMCC provides Biblically-Based, Clinically-Competent and Spirit-Sensitive counseling. This is the third in a series of articles about the JPMCC's approach to counseling as we celebrate this significant milestone!

What is Spirit-Sensitive counseling?

The JPMCC is frequently asked about the difference between Christian counseling and secular counseling. The JPMCC staff rejects the standard answers of prayer, using the Bible, and admonishing people to "do right." Why do they reject these? Is it because they do not believe in the efficacy of prayer, or the sufficiency of Scripture, or the benefit of correction? Absolutely not! But it does not take a Christian to pray, or quote scripture, or point out deficiencies. That is not what makes Christian counseling distinctively Christian.

The one true distinctive between Christian counseling and secular counseling is the presence of the Holy Spirit in the counseling session. Only when a person enters into relationship with God through Christ does that person receive the Holy Spirit. A Christian empowered by the Holy Spirit can follow the Spirit into the life of another, and this is very different. Counseling without the presence and power of the Spirit is focused on change – learning how to manage sin more effectively. However, a Christian empowered and in sync with the Holy Spirit moves towards another not for change, but for transformation. Not to manage sin, but to deliver from sin.

At the JPMCC, each staff member from the one who sits at the phone to the one who sits on the couch is asked to consider the same question at the end of day, "Could I have done what I did today without the presence and power of the Holy Spirit?" Only when they can boldly answer "No!" do they know that they have provided something distinctively Christian, distinctively Godhonoring. And nothing else is acceptable.
