

Counseling Center Celebrates 25th Anniversary

June marks the 25th anniversary of the Julianna Poor Memorial Counseling Center (JPMCC) at Houston's First Baptist Church. In this final installment in a month-long series of articles about the JPMCC, a client shares her experiences with the center's Biblically-Based, Clinically-Competent and Spirit-Sensitive counseling.

"My world was turned upside down in 2006. Using Beth Moore's words, I was "thrown into the pit." It was unexpected, it was deep, and it was very dark. I can honestly say I had no idea how to respond to the situation I found myself in. A trail of amazing people ended with a suggestion to meet with Enie Bourland at the counseling center at HFBC. I immediately begin building an argument why this wasn't going to work-it's too far to drive. I can't miss work for this, it isn't even my problem that got me here. A small voice inside me said, "Julie, it's up to you to try to be part of the solution. Call and make an appointment with Enie." Almost 2 years later, I can honestly say my counseling with Enie, including individual and group counseling, has changed my life in ways I never anticipated. I have felt genuine support and concern, and I have been gently guided to seek answers and comfort from Christ. I have been encouraged to discover all that has been hidden within me. The counseling I have received has given me a safe, structured, Christ-centered lifeline out of the darkness that had become my life. I will forever be grateful. I still don't know what my future holds, but as a healthier, more faith-filled person, I am waiting with hope to see what God will reveal." - Julie Y.





- watch the service on a TV monitor in the Main Foyer or the CLC Game Room.

At the end of the worship service, an invitation will be extended to people to accept Christ or join the church.
