





Stephen Ministry Training



Why is your Contribution Envelope Important?

Each month, members are sent envelopes that are specifically made for each member. The envelope has a number that is unique to the member. This number is what the church office uses to properly account for members' gifts for tax reporting purposes as well as applying toward pledges. With the "Be a Part of the Story" campaign in full swing, it is increasingly important to use the envelopes that have your unique number.

When completing the envelope, remember the following:



BUDGET - The "Budget" line indicates the amount of your gift you wish applied to our operating budget.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN - The "Capital Campaign" line indicates the amount of your gift you wish applied to our "Be a Part of the Story" campaign.

LOCAL MISSIONS - The "Local Missions" line indicates the amount you wish to have applied toward our local missions support.

OTHER - The "Other" line is for any of your gift intended for any other church-supported function.

CHECK NO. - The "Check No." line is for the check numbers that are placed in the envelope.
