OFF SITE PARKING

Guests are the least informed about off site parking options. When they arrive on Sunday mornings and find closed lots on campus, they do not know where else to go. Therefore, our committed and informed members must make room for them by parking at one of several off site locations:

- 300 spaces behind 701 N. Post Oak (walk across South Lot to church)
- 100 spaces at 710 N. Post Oak (shuttle to church)
- 250 spaces at 720 N. Post Oak (shuttle to church)
- 250 spaces at Marg*E (shuttle to church) Aug 23 & 30 only

Shuttles from 710 & 720 N. Post Oak drop off and pick up at the CLC and Preschool entrances. Temporary shuttles from the Marq*E on Aug 23 & 30 will drop off and pick up at the Garden Room entrance. By parking off site on Sunday mornings, you make room for ONE MORE guest at Houston's First!
