

- 100 spaces at 710 N. Post Oak (shuttle to church)
- 250 spaces at 720 N. Post Oak (shuttle to church)
- 250 spaces at Marg*E (shuttle to church) Aug 23 & 30 only

Shuttles from 710 & 720 N. Post Oak drop off and pick up at the CLC and Preschool entrances. Temporary shuttles from the Marg*E on Aug 23 & 30 will drop off and pick up at the Garden Room entrance By parking off site on Sunday mornings, you make room for **ONE MORE** guest at Houston's First!
