We see Life Bible Study as the church organized and dedicated to **Gathering** the unchurched and those who haven't discovered Christ while **Growing** believers through life changing Bible study to become Great Commission Christians, reflecting His love through *Giving* ministry to others.

Living out our Christian faith can be difficult, so having the support of fellow believers is essential. In fact, research tells us that after 5 years 83% of new Christians who are involved in a Life Bible Study remain active and engaged in the church. On the other hand, only 16% of those who are not involved in a Life Bible Study are still active.

"We encourage our Life Bible Studies to be open classes, not closed cliques," says Ben Pritchett, Minister of Education. "An open class is ready for — and wants — new people to visit every week, and it looks forward to starting new classes as attendance grows and leaders are raised up."

Fortunately, we're seeing a record number of people attending our Life Bible Studies! God is doing great things in these smaller gatherings as people of all ages come together to connect with others while they learn more about the Bible and our faith. What about you? Have you found a Life Bible Study — or have you invited somebody to come?
