Thanks to the generosity of the Houston's First family, the Great Commission Fund (or budget) for the church for 2017-18 is \$32.186.382.

To develop the budget each year, ministry directors submit their budget requests to the Leadership Team for review, discussion and approval. The proposed budget is then presented to the Finance Committee for discussion and a vote and, if approved, is then submitted to the deacons for discussion and a vote.

Once the deacons approve, the budget is presented at the monthly Church Conference where members vote to accept the budget for the upcoming fiscal year. This year, the Great Commission Fund was approved by church members at the Church Conference on Wed, June 7. It provides funding for the church from July 1. 2017, through June 30, 2018.

The budget reflects a large increase for our multisite campuses as we continue to reach more people throughout our city.


