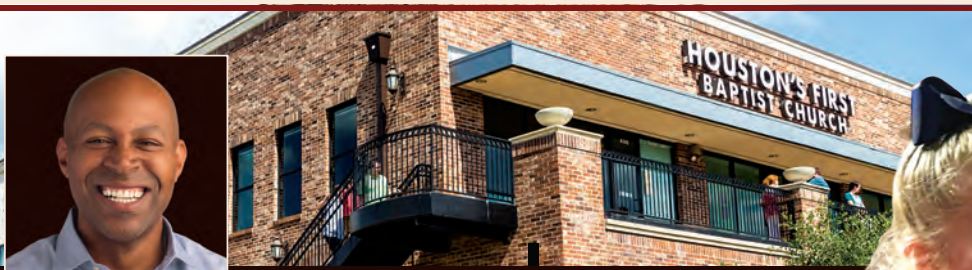

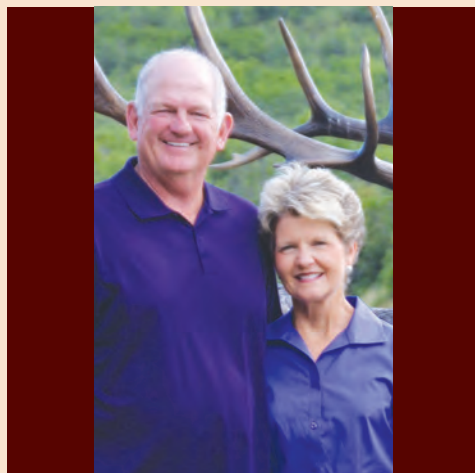


THREE thankful motivation

Granted, they could be three feet away or three miles away, but someone carries the definition “my neighbor.” One of the great blessings in life is when your neighbor is no longer defined by the distance away from you but by the opportunity for them to be near you. This change of proximity is truly a heart issue. Jesus explained this well in Luke 10:29 when asked by an attorney, “Who is my neighbor?”

The Art of Neighboring is a simple, quick read that will engage each member of Houston's First to start the process of moving towards their neighbor. This process was fast-forwarded for us all through Hurricane Harvey. Let's have the same urgency for loving our neighbor just like the many rescues made during the storm. 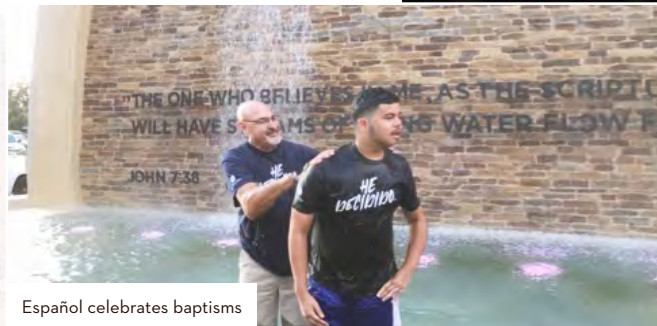
