

- Online: Giving online at HoustonsFirst.org is always a convenient way to share your generosity. Contributions submitted at HoustonsFirst.org must be made before midnight (Central) on Sun, Dec 31, 2017.
- Mobile: Contributions submitted on a mobile device must be made before midnight (Central) on Sun, Dec 31, 2017. To make a mobile contribution, download the official Houston's First Baptist Church app for iOS or Android, select your campus, and use the GIVE option.
- In Person: Contributions can be submitted during the offering moment in the worship services at every campus between now and Sun, Dec 31, 2017. If not submitted in person then, contributions must be brought to the church's Financial Services office by no later than 6:30p on that day.
