COSTA RICA

Families and mission trip "rookies" partnered with Tamarindo Church, Iglesia Casa Vida, and YWAM Liberia on labor projects, evangelism, prayer walking, VBS, a food bank, and food distribution to people in need. While there, young members of the trip chose to be baptized in the Pacific Ocean—an outward expression of the new life they received when they accepted Jesus as their Savior.

OAKLAND _____

Members from the Sienna Campus partnered with The Movement Church to serve the Oakland community and local schools. The team worked on several projects, including reorganizing and renovating the Family Resource Center at Elmhurst Community Prep, a middle school in Deep East Oakland. The Movement has a vision for growing to eight churches in Oakland serving eight public schools over the next eight years.



NEW YORK CITY___

The HUB Student Ministry's annual Rushmore trip builds off experience students gain during Rush Week in the summer. Students in 10th–12th grades connected with communities throughout the Big Apple in various ways, such as treating NYPD officers to donuts, raking leaves in Astoria Park, handing out free coffee to college students, cleaning toys donated to a church, leading worship in Central Park and the subway, and more. Along the way, they prayed for people and shared the Gospel with people they encountered.
