OUR HEART-WORKING STAFF

We've all done it-acted in ways that surprise even ourselves. A harsh word, a stubborn stance, a petty act. What is it that drives us to do things we otherwise would never do, even those of us who have given our lives to Jesus?

In Enemies of the Heart, Andy Stanley looks at four destructive forces-guilt, anger, greed, and jealousy—and how they infiltrate our lives and damage our relationships. Just like actual heart disease, we often focus on treating the symptoms rather than examining our heart to discover the source of the problem. Stanley presents a biblical approach for confronting and remedying these forces.

Houston's First staff members at each campus are reading *Enemies of the Heart* this month. Pastor Gregg has asked the staff to talk about it in team meetings with the goal of completing the book by Easter. "I'm looking forward to how the Lord will use this in our lives to grow us spiritually," he said.

"I have been both encouraged and challenged by Enemies of the Heart," says Jordan Floro, Student Minister at our Sienna Campus. "I am grateful to be a part of a church that not only values effective and excellent ministry, but is also genuinely concerned about the condition of my heart."
